

2. Registered Office: The registered office of the Trust shall be located in Rohtas district and at present shall be placed at Parasiya, P.O.+P.S. Kochas, Distt. Rohtas, Bihar, Pin Code-821112, and it can be changed at such other places as the Board of Trustees may decide from time to time.

3. Area of Operation: The operational area of the Trust shall be whole India and maybe reduced as the Trustees may decide.

- 4. <u>Administrative Office, Branches or Project Offices:</u> The administrative offices, branch offices or Project offices of the Trust will be opened at any such place and places in India which the Board of Trustees may decide in future.
- 5. - 6. Objects of the Trust: Trust will extend its services without discriminating the caste, creed, race and religion but special emphasis will be given to educationally backward in particular and weaker sections in general. The objects of Trust are to:
- Establish, run, develop and management of Hospital, 6.1 Schools and Colleges, Madrasa, Colleges, Medical Pharmacy and Dental Colleges. Nursing Institutions, Paramedical, Health Education Institutions, Polytechnics, Industrial Training Centre, Teacher's Training Colleges, (B.T., B.ed and Physical Teacher's Training Colleges etc.) Dispensaries, Maternity Homes, Technical or Nontechnical Institutions like Information Technology & Engineering Colleges, Management Institutes, Child or Women Welfare Centers and/or such similar Institutes in India for the benefit of the general public.
- 6.2 Establish, run, develop and management, assist and support schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, laboratories, research and other institutions of the like nature in India for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general.
- 6.3 Establish, run, develop and management studentships, scholarships and render other kind of aid to students including supply of books, stipends, medals and other

6.4 Promote, establish, run or manage higher education institutions for the promotion of science and technology, management, literature, music, drama and fine arts in India for the benefit of the public in general.

6.5 Establish, run, maintain or manage for the establishment and/or maintenance of parks, gardens, gymnasiums, sports clubs, dharamshalas, Mosafir Khana and rest houses for use by public in general.

6.6 Establish, run, maintain or manage shelter/homes, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people, orphans, widows, aged persons and helpless children.

6.7 Establish, run, maintain or manage Institutions or centers for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally retarded persons and to provide them education, food clothing or other helps.

Board of Trustees: The Trust shall be vested in a Board of Trustees (hereinafter called the Board) which shall consist of not less than three and not more than eleven Trustees. The first Trustees constituting the Board are:-

7.1 The first Board of Trustees shall have **one** Chairman, **one**Secretary, **one** Treasurer and **two** members. The first
Chairman of the Board will be Durga Shankar. Gorakh Nath
Patel and Hirdaya Narayan Singh will be the Secretary and
Treasurer respectively. Whereas, Upendra Singh and
Ravindra Prasad Singh will be the members of the first
Board of Trustees. All these five members as mentioned
above will be the life members of the Trust whereas, the
terms of other members will be of five years.

7.2 The first Board of Trustees shall have the power to increase the strength of the Board by appointing thereto one or more persons, whether on the same occasion or on different occasions, as Trustee or Trustees, but the total number of persons constituting the Board shall at no time exceed

eleven.

7.3 In the event of vacancies in the office of the Trust, the Board Of Trustees (B.O.T.) shall elect them from amongst themselves.

7.4 If any of the Trustees shall die, or desire to retire, refuse or become incapacitated to act as a Trustee or take the benefit of Insolvency Law, then and in every such case, there shall be a vacancy in the Board.

7.5 A Trustee may be removed from his office on following

grounds-

(i) If the Trustee becomes unfit or personally incapable to act in the Trust:(ii) if found guilty of (a) misconduct or abuse of office, (b)acting dishonestly or fraudulently, (c) misappropriation of Trust funds, (d) moral turpitude, (e) application of Trust property to private purposes etc.

A Trustee may be removed by a resolution adopted by two-third majority of the members of the Board present and voting at a meeting specially called for the purpose. The Trustees affected shall be given reasonable opportunity

to show cause against the proposed action.

Vacancies in the Board may be filled by the remaining Trustees at a meeting called for the purpose. Casual vacancies in the Board may be filled in the manner aforesaid for the unexpired part of the term of the Trustee causing the vacancy. A retiring Trustee shall be eligible for re-election.

The quorum for a meeting of the Board shall be $1/3^{rd}$ of the existing members. If the meetings have not a quorum within one hour of the fixed time, the meeting shall be adjourned to the same day and time at the same place for the next week. Adjourned meeting shall not require having a quorum.

Vacancies in the Board shall not invalidate the any of the proceedings of the Board.

7.9 The Board may meet as often as necessary and, in any event, not less than twice in a calendar year.

7.10. Decision at the meeting of the Board shall be taken by the majority of the Trustees present by unanimous decision or voting.

7.11 Notice shall be served personally or sent by post to the Board of Trustees at least seven days prior to regular meetings and 24 hours before for emergency meeting.

8 Power and Functions of the Board of Trustees:

8.1 To accept any donation, contribution, grant, loan or subscription in cash or kind, from any person(s), body of persons or Trust, Govt. /Semi Govt. Department or agency, national or international donor, with or without conditions.

To apply the whole or any part of the income of the Trust, or the Trust-Fund or accumulations thereto, to anyone or more of the objects of the Trust, as the Trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.

8.3 To convert and deal with the Trust property and/or any investments for the time being.

To invest the Trust-Fund either in the purpose of mortgage of immovable property or in shares, stock or debentures or other securities and investments, or in deposits with or loans to any company, bank, firm or any other person, and to alter, vary or transpose such investments, from time to time at the discretion of the Trustees.

8.5 To borrow or raise or secure payments of money and also to lend money either with or without security.

8.6 To sell, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust-Fund.

8.7 To let-out, demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust-Fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.

8.8 To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust-Fund.

To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this Deed of Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may from time to time think fit.

To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and 8.10 regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any Institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.

or agents or advisory committees.

To subscribe to become a member of or otherwise co-8.16 operate with any other Trust or its branch whether incorporated or not whose objects are either wholly or in part similar to those of the Trust or which could promote the interest of the Trust.

The Trustees shall, from and out of the income realised 8.17 from the properties, assets and funds of Trust, and from other such endowments, and from the Government grants, and from any other sources which they may get, expend such sum or sums of money as they may deem proper towards the maintenance of the properties of the Trust, pay all taxes, pay such sums towards the repayments of any borrowing by the Trustees and meet all expenses which the Trustees may in their discretion think necessary for the

management of the Trust, and in efficient particular, pay the salaries and allowance of all staff and servants, purchase of books, equipment and furniture's, pay management contribution for the Provident Fund of the staff, gratuity, pension etc. awards, prizes or scholarships to studentship to students and incur any other items of expenditure, relating to the Institutions, if any, under the management of the Trust not here in before specially mentioned, it being understood that the above enumeration gives not priority to any particular item or expense, nor is the same exhaustive.

No part of the Trust property or its income or any accretion 8.18 there to shall be applied for any purpose which is not a charitable or welfare purpose in law, and all provisions

hereof shall be controlled accordingly.

The Board of Trustees has management of the affairs of the 8.19 Trust and the overall supervision and superintendence of the Trust and all institutions run by the Trust and all matters incidental thereto.

Power and function of the Office-Bearers 9.

9.1 Chairman: The Chairman shall preside over all the meetings of Board Of Trustees. In the absence of the Chairman, the member present in the meeting shall elect a person amongst themselves to preside over the meeting of the Trust. He shall exercise general supervision over all the affairs of the Trust and may issue any instruction to any constituent unit of the Trust, in accordance with bye-Laws of the Trust. He shall ensure that the regular meetings are held as per scheduled time and the emergency meetings, held as per need for object of the Trust. He shall have to see that resolutions of meeting are implemented properly and timely. He will also sign the resolution of the meeting of the Trust written in proceeding register.

Secretary: The Secretary will be the chief functionary as 9.2 well as the implementing body for any decision of the Trust. The Secretary will implement all decisions, resolutions adopted in the meeting of the Trust. He will also put up the annual as well as action taken report in the meeting to get it approved by B.o.T. He will also put the annual budget for income and expenditure for its approval from the B.o.T. He will pass bill and voucher against payment. He will also make all correspondences and also sign necessary papers

and documents on behalf of the Trust. He will issue notices, notification and office orders in light of resolution adopted in the meeting either with prior permission or direction of the chairman of Trust. He will also sign the resolution of the meeting of the Trust written in proceeding register. He will be custodian of all papers, documents and register of the Trust.

9.3 Treasurer: The Treasurer will look after the financial matter under control of the Trust. He will prepare the annual budget for income and expenditure in consultation with Secretary. He will have to ensure the accounts work completed by 31st March every year and to get it audited by chartered accountant by the month of may every year. He has to consult the Secretary in all such matters for better and smooth functioning of the audit works under the Trust. He will also sign the resolution of the meeting of the Trust written in proceeding.

10. Accounts and Audit:

The account or accounts of the Trust shall be opened by the name of the Trust and/or branches, project offices centers or Institutions run or conducted by the Trust with a Nationalised or Scheduled bank or other banks approved or permitted by Reserve Bank of India or in Post Office and it shall be operated by Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer. They shall be responsible for all types of transaction. All the cheques and withdrawal slips shall be signed by the Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer.

10.2 The accounts of the Trust shall be audited every year by a Charted Accountant or a firm of Chartered Accountants that

will be appointed by the Board of Trustees.

The audited accounts of the Trust shall be adopted at a meeting of the Board of Trustees called for the purpose, and remuneration of the Chartered Accountant or Firm of Chartered Accountants shall be fixed by the Board of Trustees.

11. Power to amalgate:

The Board of Trustees may allow and permit any other Trust, Institution or Charity, in any local area or areas whose objects are either wholly or in part similar to those of these presents to the intent and effect that such other Trust, Institution or charity shall be deemed to be a part and parcel of the Trust created by these Presents, provided that no conditions are accepted which involve a change in the name of this Trust or inconsistent with or repugnant to the objects of this Trust

The Trustees shall be chargeable only for such money, 12.1 stocks, funds, deposits and securities as they shall actually receive, not withstanding their signing any receipt for the sake or conformity, and shall by answerable or accountable of only for their own deliberate or willful acts of omission or commission.

No Trustee shall be liable for any breach of trust committed 12.2 the Co-Trustee except in respect of his own act and in

respect of any property in his custody. Power to Re-imbrues:

The Trustees of these Present are entitled to be reimbursed and also to pay and discharge out of the Trust-Fund, all expenses incurred by them or on their behalf in or about the execution of the Trust and the powers of these presents

Allowance to Trustees & Office-bearers: 14. If at any time any Trustee acts as a whole time office-bearer

of the Trust or renders any special service, the Board of Trustees may in its discretion pay such remuneration or

allowance to such Trustee as it may think proper.

15. Accounting year of the Trust:

The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31st March every year.

Amendments: 16.

The Terms, Rules and Regulations of this Deed of Trust may be amended, altered or modified for better management and administration by a majority of 2/3rd members of the Board Of Trustees present and voting in a meeting called for the purpose.

Provided, however, that no amendment contrary to the objects of the Trust hereinbefore set forth shall be valid and effective.

17 Jurisdiction of Courts:

The competent court in district Rohtas shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide any question regarding the construction this Deed interpretation and of administration of the Trust and the related matters. In the event of such courts having concurrent jurisdiction with any other court or courts in respect of any claim or dispute against or by the Trust or Trustees or any other matter connected therewith, the competent courts in district Rohtas, shall have jurisdiction to entertain, try and determine such claim or dispute in exclusion of such other court or courts.

Dissolution of The Trust: In the case of dissolution of the Trust, the remaining assets of the Trust shall be handed over to any other Trust for application for similar aims and objects.
